The Black Canyon City Chamber of Commerce will present its eleventh annual fundraising event on Saturday, November 2, 2019, at the historic Rock Springs Café, ten minutes north of Anthem at I-17 exit 242 in the shadow of the Bradshaw Mountains. The doors open at 4:00 pm.

This year's Tombstone Nights will again feature live music for your listening enjoyment and dancing from 5:00 pm till 10:00 pm.

A silent auction will run from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm and casino games will provide action at Black Jack and Roulette tables from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm, hosted by the famous local icon Arizona Duuude. The gambler with the most chips at 9:00 pm will win a special prize to be announced at the beginning of the gaming session. Raffles for various prizes will be conducted periodically throughout the evening and the winner of the 50/50 raffle will be announced at 9:00 pm.

Event tickets are \$20 per person when purchased in advance, or \$25 at the door. The ticket price includes three glasses of wine (or a non-alcohol beverage), pulled pork sandwiches with beans and coleslaw, Rock Springs pie, snacks such as cheese, crackers, fruit, nuts and chocolate, and \$500 in "poker chips". \$500 of additional gaming chips may be purchased for \$15 anytime during the gaming session.
