

Rules for 12/3/22 Poker Chip Run:

1. At registration, riders will receive a participation wristband, scorecard and map.
2. Participants must go to all five stops on the poker chip run course before a deadline.
3. At each stop, the participant draws one (1) unseen poker chip from the volunteer's container. The volunteer will mark tally sheets of participant and score keeper with the color of the chip drawn. The chip will then be returned to the container.
4. When all participants have completed drawing a chip at each of the five stops, the chip values will be determined as follows: One chip of each color will be placed into an opaque container. A participant will withdraw one unseen chip from the container. That chip color will be valued at twenty (20) points. Another participant will withdraw a second unseen chip from the container. That chip color will be valued at ten (10) points. The remaining chip color will be valued at five (5) points.
5. The judges will then score the cards with the chip values and declare the winners. The highest score wins 25% of the registration proceeds and the lowest score wins 25% of the registration proceeds.
6. In case of a tie score, those participants will each draw one unseen chip from the judge's container. The original chip color value is still in effect. If that results in a tie, the procedure will be repeated until one participant prevails.
